Founded in 1996, the Geo-Institute (G-I) of the American Society of Civil Engineers is one of the eight specialty Institutes of ASCE.

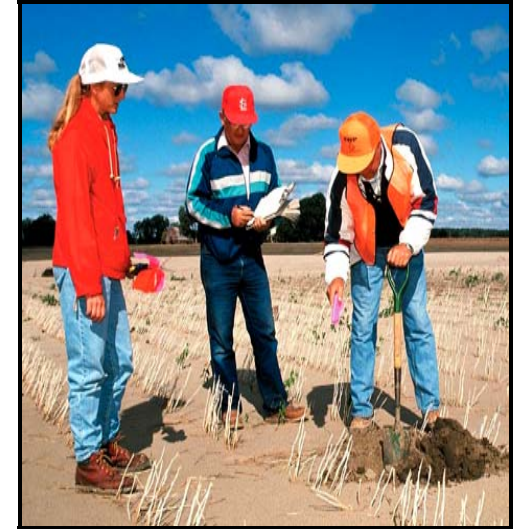
